



The Season

- Registration opens in November and closes after the final Tryout / Skills Assessment
- Teams are formed in late February and parents should be contacted by the Coach in early March
- Optional practices are usually held the week of spring break with regular practices beginning the following week
- Games schedules will be developed in March with games beginning in early April and continuing through May
- Tournament play begins in June with the Tournament of Champions featuring the top Minors and Majors teams in the District
- All Star teams begin practicing in June with District & State tournaments continuing through July

Gear / Uniforms

- The League provides each team with bats, helmets, practice balls, game balls, catcher equipment, and First Aid Kits
- The League provides each team with uniforms. This is accomplished through a partnership with the [AZ Diamondbacks](#) and by purchasing from local vendors.
- At a minimum, parents should be prepared to provide a glove and cleats for their player. Parents are welcome to provide their player with any additional gear that you feel necessary such as a bag, batting gloves, helmet, catcher equipment or a bat.
 - If you purchase a new bat, Little League has a specific standard for bats that can be used. Please refer to the [USA Baseball Performance Standard](#) for details.

Tryout / Skills Assessment

- This event allows the League and Team Managers the opportunity to assess player development and provides the evaluation needed to accomplish the draft process for the Majors Division
- The League requires that all players that are League Age 10-12 attend this event.
 - [For Baseball](#): players born on or before August 31, 2010
 - [For Softball](#): players born on or before December 31, 2009
- All players that register for Prescott Valley Little League are guaranteed to be on a team – this assessment helps the League assign players appropriately between the Minors & Majors Divisions.

Eligibility

Little League rules require that player eligibility must be established either by residency or school enrollment

RESIDENCY SHALL BE ESTABLISHED AND SUPPORTED BY:
 Documents containing the full residence which includes **parent(s) or court-appointed guardian(s) name, street address, city, state, and zip code information, dated or in force between February 1 of the previous year and February 1 of the current year, from ONE or more documents from EACH of the three groups outlined below:**

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE SHALL BE ESTABLISHED AND SUPPORTED BY:
 A document indicating enrollment for the current academic year, dated prior to October 1 of previous year, and with the physical location of the school from **ONE of the following categories:**

- The School Enrollment Form provided by Little League (LittleLeague.org/SchoolEnrollmentForm)
- Official/Certified enrollment record, confirming current enrollment, that includes the school's physical address and the original signature of the school's senior administrator (principal, headmaster, etc.)

NOTE: A school-issued report card/performance record will no longer be accepted to establish school attendance.
